## **Complex Distal Radius Fracture**

## **Post-Operative Guidelines**

- Begin active range of motion of your fingers immediately; remember to elevate and use ice to control swelling
- Your splint/dressing should remain on until your first postoperative visit which will be 8-14 days after surgery and will be on your discharge paperwork
- Your splint and sutures will be removed at your first postoperative visit, and you will be placed in a cast for 5-6 weeks
- After your cast is removed, you will be placed in a removable wrist splint and we will order hand therapy for motion
- Hand therapy for aggressive motion and grip strengthening will typically begin at 8 weeks from surgery after you are cleared by your surgeon
