

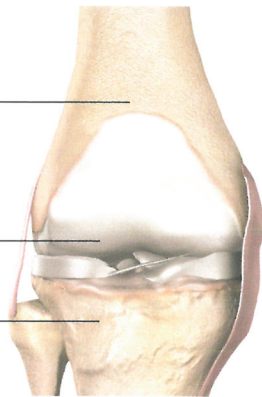
Total Knee Replacement

Tibia (shin bone)

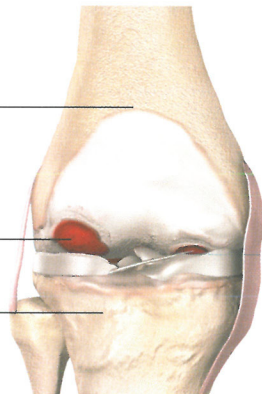


An Arthritic Knee

Tibia (shin bone)



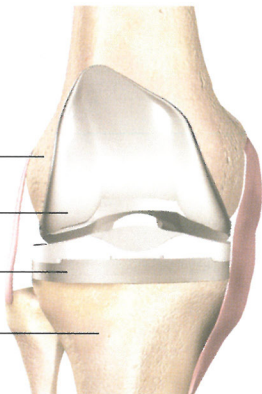
